



# ~For health care and long-term care insurance subscribers ~ Combined High-Cost Medical/Long-Term Care Benefits



The combined copayment system is intended to ease the burden of households which use both health care and long-term care insurances with high out-of-pocket expenses. In mid-December, notifications will be sent to eligible households with insurance subscribers to the medical system for the latter-stage elderly. In mid-January 2018, notifications will be sent to households with national health insurance enrollees.

※ A notification may not be sent if the health care insurance was changed between August 2016 and July 2017.

#### 2017 Social Insurance Premium Deduction Certificate

Social insurance premium deduction certificates (postcards) which provide proof of national pension contribution payments are mailed by the Japan Pension Service in the beginning of November to individuals who made contributions between January 1 and September 30. To those who started making contribution payments on or after October 1, the certificates will be mailed at the beginning of February 2018. Be sure to safe keep the certificate as it would be needed for the year-end adjustment and the final income tax return. The full amount of the total national pension contribution payments can be claimed as deductions for social insurance premiums against income tax, city resident tax, etc.

# December 3 – 9 People with Disabilities Week

Do you know the Symbol for Access with Disabilities? In addition to the International Symbol of Access, there are symbols which have been designated by each organization for disabilities. If you find these symbols in street, in shops or in any facility, your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.



#### Sign Language Mark

It shows that the staff can communicate in sign language. People with hearing impairments can show it to the staff if they want to be dealt with in sign language.

#### Communication by Writing Mark

This is to show that the hearing impaired persons can communicate via writing.



#### Assistance Dogs Mark



This is a sticker designed by Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare to promote accompaniment of assistance dogs. They are posted at the entrance of various facilities and stores.



#### International Symbol of Access for the Blind

This was established by the World Blind Union in 1984. It is put up at buildings which are barrier- free and consider the safety of the blind and visually impaired.

#### What is universal design?

The difference between universal design and barrier-free.

Both aim to create a society where everyone can live easily and comfortably. While there is no barrier from the beginning in the idea of universal design because it is for all, barrier-free aims to remove barriers which the disabled or the elderly might experience in our current society. We are familiar with the following for instance.

#### Barrier-free mentality

According to the attitude survey conducted by the 5<sup>th</sup> Ashiya Welfare Project, 33.4% of people with disabilities answered, "Often" or "Sometimes" to the question, "Have you ever experienced discrimination or prejudice?" Many of them want understanding for people with disabilities. Making a user-friendly product or create barrier-free facilities, for example, installing a slope for wheel chair users, is not enough. It is important for each of us to have a bit of sympathy and to put ourselves in somebody else's place.

#### What are Assistance Dogs?

The national and local governments shall endeavor to promote citizens' understanding of significant role assistance dogs play. Assistance dogs for people with physical disabilities refers to guide dogs, mobility service dogs

and hearing dogs. Department stores or restaurants where large numbers of people frequent cannot not

refuse assistance dogs and their users.

Do not stare at or speak to assistance dogs, nor give them food or water. If an assistance dog user seems to be having trouble, ask the user if they need help.

# Saika Tomita "A Man of Wind"

#### 

Do you know about the former house of Saika Tomita in Miyagawa-cho, Ashiya City? Saika Tomita, a poet, accomplished great achievements in the world of poetry from the Taisho to Showa period. The building, donated by Saika's family, has been open to the public since May 1987 with valuable materials on display including his library collection and research materials. This year marks the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of its opening to the public.

#### ■ Two Nick Names: "Wind" and "Father of Hyogo Culture"

He had two nicknames. His first nickname was "Wind" which is thought to have come from his image when traveling across the country. In fact, he left footsteps throughout the country, and travel photos, folk crafts that he collected on his travels are kept as his mementoes.

After the war, he wrote the lyrics to more than 50 school songs and city and town songs. School songs of Seido Junior High School, Miyagawa and Seido Elementary Schools in Ashiya City were written by him. It is said that he went all the way to the actual places when he wrote the lyrics.

Furthermore, Saika, being commissioned by Hyogo Prefecture, wrote the words of the "Hyogo Sanka" (a song in praise of Hyogo) in 1971. It is a magnificent, long poem in which he describes the five provinces (Settsu, Awaji, Harima, Tanba, Tajima) as five flower petals. Those great achievements gave him the second nickname,

the "Father of Hyogo Prefecture" in his honor.

#### A Place Associated with A Great Literary Figure, Junichiro Tanizaki

The former house of Saika Tomita used to be the house of Junichiro Tanizaki. Because of the Great Kanto Earthquake of 1923, he moved to the Hanshin area (around the cities of Osaka and Kobe) and lived there for 21 years, during which he moved thirteen times.

From March 1934 to November 1936, he lived in this house, Tanizaki's "Uchide no Ie", where he married his third wife, Matsuko, and lived together with her sisters. He wrote "Neko to Shozo to Futari no Onna" (A Cat, A Man, and Two Women) in 1936 and began translating of "The Tale of Genji" into modern Japanese on the second floor of the storeroom currently used as an exhibition area.

The main building was destroyed in August 1945, by Great Hanshin Air Raid. Only the present exhibition building, a pine tree beside the gate and a stone lantern in the garden still exist as they originally were.

#### ■ Highlights of the Former House of Saika Tomita

You can see traces of Saika's life everywhere. One of the charms is a garden, in which various trees and flowers are growing from season to season. At first glance, it appears to be unarranged, uncared for a garden, but this is the landscape created by Saika who equally valued the life of naturally grown plants and plants his friends brought him. Nostalgic items including a chest of drawers, a porch, and *kotatsu* (a small table with an electric heater underneath and covered by a quilt) are displayed in the main building. You can also read

his works freely, so please come and feel his character and passion, enjoying the view of the garden from the porch.

#### <Profile of Saika Tomita>

Saika Tomita was born in 1890 in Morioka City, Iwate Prefecture. Describing the life and sentiments of ordinary people in everyday language, and translating Western poetry into Japanese, Tomita, as a democratic poet, introduced Western democratic ideas into Japan during the Taisho democracy period. As he suffered from tuberculosis in 1913, he visited a friend in Ashiya for a change of air for his health. For that reason, he decided to move to Ashiya, and lived in this house from 1939 until he died at the age of 93 in 1984.

# Nursing Care Techniques

Yasuyo Tsukumo (An authorized nurse for dementia care)

When you care for a parent or spouse with dementia at home, what should you or your family take care to do?

In care at home, not exclusively for those with dementia, it often happens that the more seriously a caregiver tries, the more easily he/she feels cornered. Perhaps, as one cause, the caregiver feels cornered because of being bound by the image of what a nursing care should be like. There are various kinds of nursing care just like various colors in life. It is important for you to make use of your own original and inventive ideas and find out the best way between you and the care receiver, without being bound by only one idea.

You are facing a "living person" in nursing care, while you face a "patient" in medical care. Here is one point you must remember; the protagonist is "the person who receives care."

The best secret for success in nursing care is a simple rule that "Never do what a care receiver hates." That doesn't mean simply to respect "self-decision", but it means the "joint decision" between a caregiver and a care receiver.

Furthermore, how about looking it from a different angle, such as "Dementia is another culture"? If you see a person have problem behavior caused by dementia, do not regard the person as "abnormal" and yourself as "normal", but think that the person is in "another culture"; just as customs are different between Japanese and foreigners. Actually, many problems cannot be solved even if you get angry, shackled by common sense. Only with a little change in your viewpoint, will you feel less anger?

It is very important in nursing care that the caregiver and care receiver are mutually regarded as "equal human beings". Understanding the partner without discrimination or prejudice is the first step to communication, and it will enable you to care without worrying too much.







#### 221 Years Ago - The Edo Period

- Saigoku Road and Ashiya depicted in "Settsu Menshov Zue"-

Ashiya has been an important place for connecting the eastern and western parts of the country. In ancient times, the Sanyo Road passed through here connecting the capital, Kyoto and Dazaifu Shrine which is dedicated to Sugawara no Michizane, the patron saint of scholarship, in current Fukuoka prefecture,

In the Edo period, the Saigoku Road, took a route through Ashiya. Saigoku literally means "western countries". At Uchide, it branched off to the Main Road along the mountains and to the Hama (beach) Road along the seaside. The Main Road was used mainly by persons of high standing such as a daimyo's procession, and the Hama Road was used by common people. The road was given in, "Settsu Meisho Zue" published in 1796. This is an illustrated guide book full of sceneries and historic sites in Settsu, the north part of the current Osaka City and the southeast part of Hyogo prefecture.

Illustrations of people coming and going along the seaside road, Uchide beach, and pine groves along the Ashiyagawa River are in the chapters for Ashiya. There are also descriptions of the Kanatsuyama *Kofun*, (burial mound) and Abo-shinnno-zuka *Kofun* – Burial mound of the imperial prince (792–842). They were already known as historic sites in the Edo Period.

Those pages recall to mind the bygone days. Wouldn't you like to go along the Saigoku Road where the Edo people once travelled?
